## CBISA: Community Benefit Reporting Tool

The increased scrutiny by the IRS on 501(r) compliance and the ongoing debate in Washington about the 340B program have made it more important than ever to be able to organize and document your hospital's community benefit activities. A well-thought-out and systematic planning process is critical to having a community benefit strategy that builds on community assets, promotes collaboration and improves community health.

Many reporting requirements exist including the Internal Revenue Service 990 Schedule H. To assist hospitals with reporting their community benefit activities, the Kansas Hospital Association provides all members access to the Community Benefit Inventory for Social Accountability software at no additional cost.

Join us at 10 a.m. on June 22 for an educational webinar, when Trina Hackensmith, vice president of Lyon Software, will discuss:

- An overview and demonstration of the CBISA community benefit reporting tool offered to KHA members;
- Tools and resources available to assist hospitals in reporting community benefits;
