

EXECUTIVE ORDERS ISSUED BY GOVERNOR KELLY AS OF June 7, 2021

- EO 20-03 – Extends State of Local Disaster Emergency related to CoVID-19. **Expired 5/26/2020**
- EO 20-04 – Prohibits gatherings of more than 50 people **Rescinded by 20-14**
- EO 20-05 – Temporarily prohibiting utility and internet disconnects. **Expired 5/26/2020**
- EO 20-07 – Temporarily closing K-12 schools to slow the spread of COVID-19. **Expired 5/26/2020**
- EO 20-08 – Temporarily expands capacity in the healthcare system. **Replaced by 20-35 5/26/2020.**
- EO 20-09 – Provides conditional and temporary relief from certain motor carrier rules and regulations **Replaced by 20-44 5/26/2020**
- EO 20-10 – Temporary suspends foreclosures/evictions. **Expired 5/26/2020**
- EO 20-11 – Prevents all Kansas waste removal providers, trash and recycling, from cancelling or suspending commercial or residential waste or recycling removal services for Kansas residences and businesses. **Expired 5/26/2020**
- EO 20-12 – Extends deadlines for driver's licenses and vehicle registration renewals and regulations. **Replaced by 20-36 5/26/2020.**
- EO 20-13 – Extends tax filing deadlines to July 15, 2020, and waives any interest and penalties for returns and payments made on or before July 15, 2020. **Replaced by 20-37 5/26/2020**
- EO 20-14 – Prohibits gatherings of more than 10 people. **Rescinded by 20-18**
- EO 20-15 – Gives guidance on the following of Kansas Essential Function Framework (KEFF) guidelines when issuing a stay-at-home order. **Expired 5/26/2020**
- EO 20-16 – Statewide Stay-at-Home Order in effect from 1201am March 30 until April 19, 2020. **Extended & Expired to 5/3/2020**
- EO 20-17 – Temporarily waives the one-week waiting period requirement for unemployment and removes the requirement for the recipient of the benefits to actively be searching for work. **Replaced by 20-38 5/26/2020**
- EO 20-18 – Add religious institutions and funerals to the Mass Gatherings (4/7/2020) - overturned by Legislative Coordinating Council (4/8/2020). **Reinstated by Supreme Court Ruling. Rescinded by EO 20-25.**
- EO 20-19 – Extends professional and occupational licenses through the end of the pandemic and 90 days thereafter. **Replaced by 20-39 5/26/2020**
- EO 20-20 – Temporarily authorizes notaries and witnesses to operate remotely via audio and video technology. **Replaced by 20-40 5/26/2020**
- EO 20-21 – Temporarily precludes the sale of out of state turkey licenses. **Expired 5/26/2020**
- EO 20-22 – Temporarily extends relief to motor carriers participating in CoVID-19 response. **Rescinded after expiration 5/15/2020**
- EO 20-23 – Temporary suspension of licensing visits and inspections at Adult Care Homes. **Replaced by 20-41 5/27/2020**
- EO 20-24 – Extends Executive Order 20-16 Stay at Home Order date from April 19 to May 3, 2020. **Expired 5/3/2020**
- EO 20-25 – Gives clarification to the limiting of mass gatherings to 10 or less people and rescinds EO 20-18. **Expired 5/3/2020**
- EO 20-26 – Temporarily eases licensing restrictions for medical professionals. **Expired 5/26/2020**
- EO 20-27 – Allows the sale, for certain licenses, of alcoholic beverages for carryout consumption and permits the sale of liquor in a container that is not the original. **Replaced by 20-42 5/27/2020**
- EO 20-28 - Specifically extends Executive Orders 20-03, 05, 07, 08, 10, 11, 12, 13, 15, 16, 17, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, and 27, until the new disaster declaration expires, or as subsequently extended or terminated. **Expired**
