Increased Penalties for Violence against Health Care Workers Posters

The Kansas Hospital Association created a series of posters to be used in your facilities to raise awareness about the increased penalties for acts of violence against health care workers. We have created template posters in Canva for your use. There are posters for public and employee spaces.

There are two sets of posters. The first set of posters is for external audiences – the public and patients – they highlight patience, kindness, respect and healing. The public posters have light blue and gray accents. The second set of posters is for internal use in breakrooms, locker rooms and staff areas – they urge staff to report acts of violence. The employee posters have royal blue and yellow accents.

To maintain consistency in language please use the following when describing the new penalties:

Assault of a health care worker is a Class A misdemeanor that carries a maximum sentence of one year's jail time and a \$2,500 fine.
