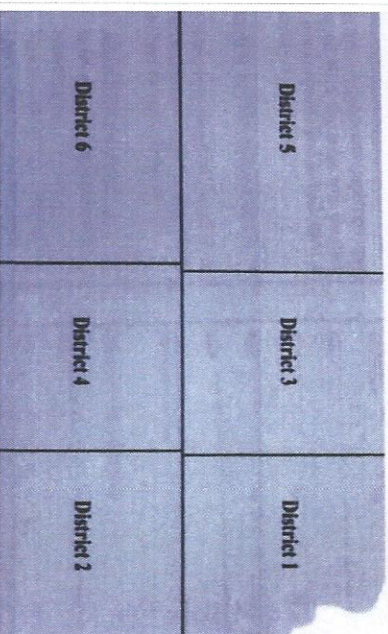

The HVK Board of Directors is composed of volunteer leaders from all areas of Kansas. The HVK Board is the coordinating body for all of the activities of our organization.

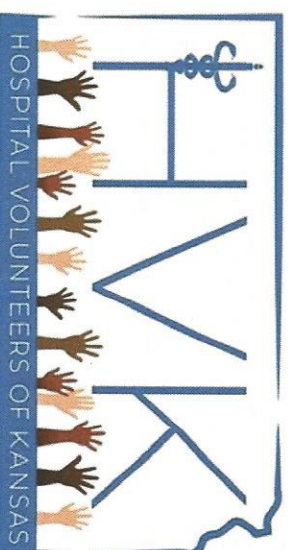
