KHA Board Takes Action on COVID-19

(November 19, 2020) – The Kansas Hospital Association Board of Directors adopted a statement during their Nov. 18, 2020, board meeting. The following statement, on the statewide efforts to combat the spike in COVID-19 cases, was unanimously supported.

“The Kansas Hospital Association strongly believes it is essential for Kansans to use face coverings, maintain social distancing and handwashing to limit the community spread of COVID-19”.

The KHA Board of Directors allocated funding to support these statewide efforts.
