WOMEN IN HEALTHCARE

Preference given to juniors and seniors. Essay application based. Limited to 14 female students from across Kansas - all regions included in final selections. Three day all-inclusive experience at KU Medical Center with hands on learning from staff - featuring women leaders in medicine when possible.

JOURNEYS & DESTINATIONS

Regional one-day health career exploration for high school students. Typically six speakers provided. Low cost to high schools. Registration by groups of 10 per school.

NIGHT AT THE LAB

Think health related science fair. Team based. Topics provided by the AHEC. Regionals are currently virtual and occur in the fall. Winners from each region invited to compete at KU Medical Center for a two day experience, typically early December. Hotel, meals, and experience provided by the AHEC
