Over the last several years, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services have increased requirements related to health equity and addressing social determinants of health. What has been lacking was reimbursement to pay hospitals and clinics for this work. Fortunately, the 2024 Medicare Physician Fee Schedule includes G-codes that cover some services related to social determinants of health. Additionally, KanCare began reimbursing for community health worker services beginning July 1, 2023.
