The Intersection of Pain Management and Opioid Use Disorder

Chronic pain and opioid use disorder are complex conditions that impact thousands of Kansans, cause significant disability and are challenging to manage. Join us Tuesday, August 13, as Daniel Warren, MD, discusses the intersection of pain management and opioid use disorder.

This presentation will help participants improve patient satisfaction with pain and addiction treatment; reduce AMA discharges and prevent unnecessary readmissions; and help providers feel more capable and less burdened in treating these conditions.

Guest speaker, Dr. Warren, trained in family medicine while active duty in the US Navy. After completing his military service, he completed an addiction medicine fellowship in Oregon before returning to Kansas. His current clinical practice focuses on medical treatment of opioid use disorder, as both medical director of an opioid treatment program and buprenorphine prescriber at a safety-net clinic.

This webinar is the third in a series of opioid-related provider education webinars offered in 2024 for clinicians, quality professionals and hospital leaders.
