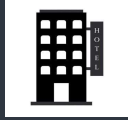

# KHA Workers' Compensation Fund & Safety Seminar

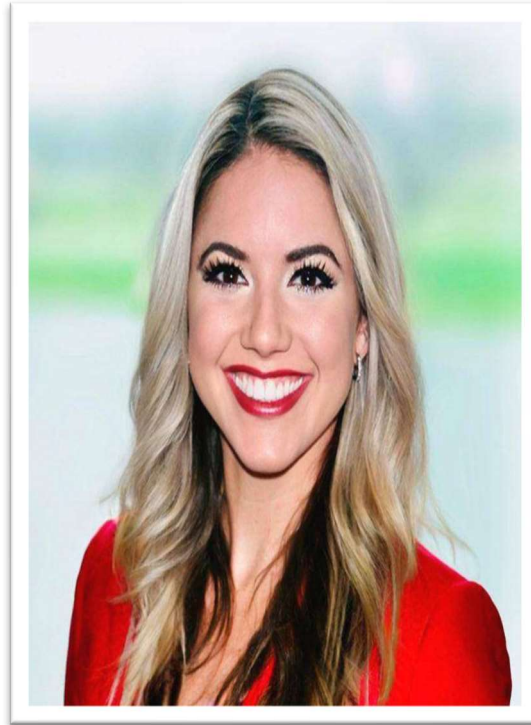

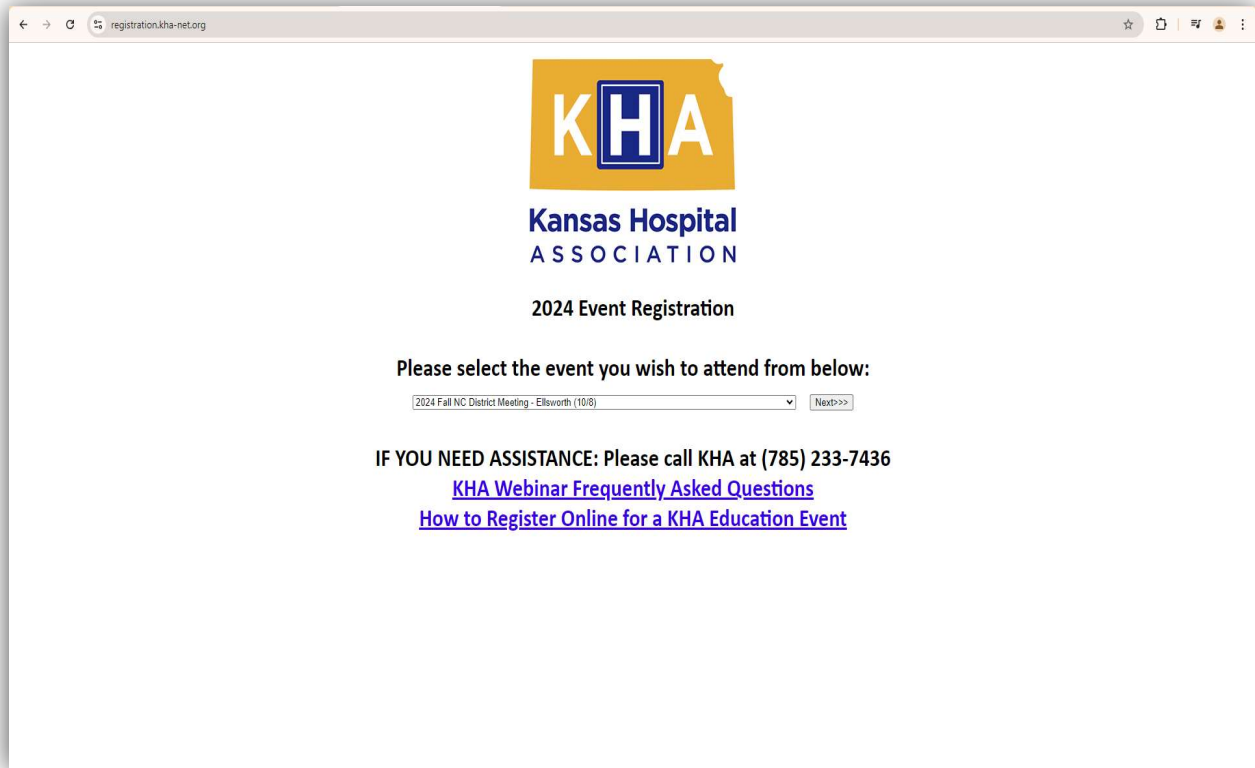
