## Commonly Misused Over-the-Counter Medications: What Providers and Clinicians Should Know

Over-the-counter medications are generally safe when used as recommended. However, as with prescription and illicit drugs, OTCs can be misused, resulting in adverse events and even overdose. Ashley Haynes, MD, will provide an overview for providers and clinicians of the most commonly misused OTC medications, their risks, adverse effects and how to address OTC misuse.

Dr. Haynes is board certified in addiction medicine and practices in Wichita at the Robert J. Dole Veteran's Administration Medical Center. Dr. Haynes received her Doctor of Medicine from the University of Kansas School of Medicine, completed her residency in internal medicine and emergency medicine at East Carolina School of Medicine and fellowship in toxicology at the University of Texas Southwestern in Dallas. Dr. Haynes currently practices addiction medicine at the Veteran's Administration in Wichita, performing bedside consultations, managing patients at a residential treatment center and managing patients in a buprenorphine clinic.

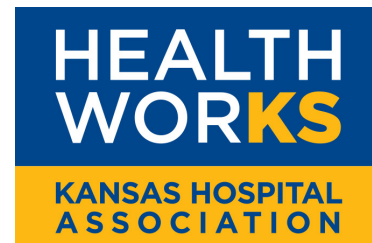
