## Integrating Substance Use Disorder Treatment into Primary Care

The primary care physician may be the first health care professional to be aware of a patient's substance use disorder or of a relapse. As a trusted guardian of the patient's well-being, treating the patient at the primary care level can have benefits. Join us for a webinar on April 30 to learn about physician perceptions of treating addiction and hear from a physician and a clinician who have successfully integrated substance use disorder treatment into primary care. Elizabeth Ablah, PhD, University of Kansas School of Medicine, population health department, will share the results of a recent survey conducted of physicians on treating patients with SUD disorder. The survey was part of a larger initiative, *Preparing Physicians to Treat Addiction*. Dr. Ablah will then facilitate a discussion about integrating SUD treatment into their practices.

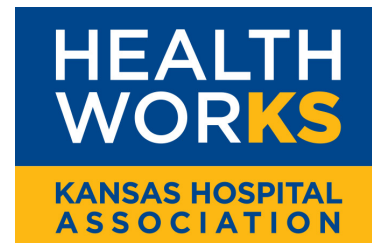
